July 21, 2021

Jr. Fair Building - John Miles County Park

1. Meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by president, Tom Ash. Those in attendance include: Ken Pabich, Laura Vlies, Dan Austad, Roy Englebert, John White, Thad Ash, Wayne Spritka, Aaron Ash, JJ Schopf, Tim Ash, Dawn Vandevort, Sara Mueller, Tom Ash, and Steve Jennerjohn.
2. Steve moved to approve the agenda. Thad second. Motion carried.
3. Thad moved to approve the July 7th minutes. Steve second. Motion carried.
4. Liaison Report - Roy asked about pricing for an exhibitor.
5. Fairest of the Fair- Laura shared about some of the events the fairest has been up to. Michaela has recorded a Door County Daily News interview and commercial. The Fairest's schedule for the fair was shared. Claire Olson will be present to help out where needed for the program. They had a low expense year. They will have booth space in the Jr. Fair building during fair week.
6. Contracts - Names for hotel reservations need to be given to Tom. Size of campers needs to be confirmed. The UW Marching Band has cancelled their appearance at the 2021 fair due to lack of student participation. Steve has a document of all of the contracted needs for bands. DockDogs are encouraging pre-registration. The passenger van is secured for the BoDeans and John has a driver lined up.
7. Vendors- 48 vendors so far. Thresheree will be selling raffle tickets and providing a raffle license copy for our records.
8. Sponsors/Marketing- tractor supply donated sanitizer and shavings.
9. Remaining prep- copy of pass samples are needed for all gates. Stand coupons need to be made and shared with all stands. Each stand gets 10 buttons and 6 parking passes. Many thanks and praises given to the Parks and Facilities crew for their hard work and early set up. 16 buttons going to the fairest of the fair for the coloring contest from last year. 2022 dates will depend on the carnival availability.
