MEMBERS PRESENT: Commissioner Bill Karas, Chairman Don Sitte.

1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER.

The meeting was called to order at 10:30am.

2. THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE WAS READ.

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES.

Minutes of the 13 Apr 2021 meeting were unanimously approved.

4. CVSO REPORT.

CVSO reported that her and the assistant were working on finishing up the annual budget for 2022 to turn into the Finance Department.

CVSO reported that the VA continues to process benefits at a slow pace primarily due to the National Personnel Records Center working with limited staffing and is now starting to catch up from the back log created by COVID-19.

5. COMMISSION AID.

As of 2021 \$3,925.00 of the Commission Aid has been distributed to needy veterans.

6. OPEN FORUM/DISCUSSION.

a. The 2021 Veterans Day Ceremony will be held on Thursday, November 11th in Gibraltar at the Door County Auditorium. Arrangements will be solidified at the beginning of the school year.

b. The 2021 Memorial Day ceremonies held in Sturgeon Bay and Fish Creek went really well and were widely attended. Commissioner Sitte thanked Assistant CVSO, Nathan LeClair for providing a list of deceased veterans from Door County to be read at the ceremony in Fish Creek.

c. A fundraising opportunity was discussed due to the fact that the annual Armed Forces Day Breakfast was not held. A t-shirt sale and/or golf outing has been suggested in order to raise funds for the Veterans Service Council funds.
